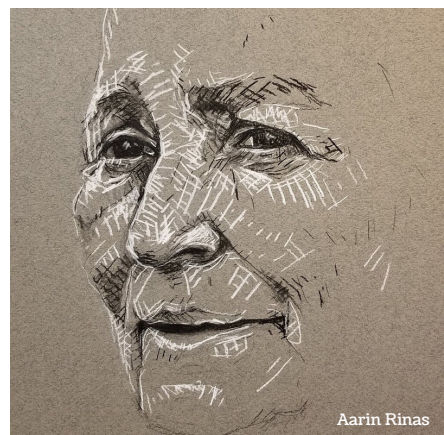

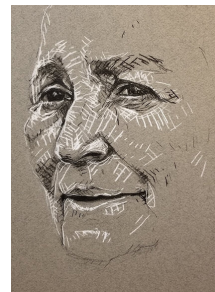

Studio

Capacity 75 person, upstairs, large open room with skylight, includes chairs and tables.

Capacity of 10-12 person. . Meeting room on main floor with board table and chairs.

Pottery Studio

Capacity of 10-12 person. Full pottery studio with wheels, glazing area, slab rollers, etc. located in the basement.
